MEMBER RAY TWEEDIE HAS BEEN IN THE PROCESS OF AMENDING THE 2012 RULES OF PROCEDURE SINCE A STATEMENT WAS MADE BY THE CHAIR IN APRIL 2014

<p>Enacted April 14, 1998 Revised November 10, 2009 Adopted December 9, 2009.</p>	<p>At the June 6, 2012 planning board meeting," Member Tweedie spoke on the Rules of Procedure, Section 5:2, Standing Committees. He feels the Rules of Procedure should reflect the active Committee and the work they perform. The Board agreed that this should be tabled to the July 10th to allow for time to research the amendment procedure."</p>	<p>From April 2014 till now (July 2014)</p>
	<p>At the July 10, 2012, p.b. meeting," Member Tweedie, explained that Planning Administrator Reed had revised them according to the discussion at the last Rules and Regulations Meeting (no record in minutes). The Board will need to move this forward for a public hearing. He pointed out the change was mostly at the top of page 3, which addresses four standing committees. The Board does not use a Zoning Committee so there was a change to section 3.2.3. The policies are now in line with how the Planning Board conducts business."</p>	<p>"Chairman Epperson stated that it came to his attention that the Rules of Procedure that the Planning Board is governed under was really not being followed to the law. What the Board was doing was really not reflecting what the old rules said. He pointed out that Member Tweedie has reviewed the Rules of Procedure to bring it up to date" (Planning Board meeting, April 08, 2014). Member Tweedie submitted his changes to the Board for their review. Motion by Keriann Roman to consider for review the proposed changes of the Rules of Procedure to be adopted at the next meeting with any edits the Board desires to make at that time. Seconded by Jerry Gittlein. Rules of Procedure automatically tabled until the May 2014 meeting.</p>
	<p>At the August 14, 2012 p.b. meeting, "Motion by Curtis Boivin to accept the revised Planning Board Rules of Procedure as submitted at the July 10, 2012 meeting. Seconded by Phil Winslow. All in favor." (Member Tweedie who was responsible for the changes was not present.)</p>	<p>At the May 5th, 2014, p.b. meeting " Alternate Quinn asked about the status of the proposed changes to Rules and Regulations. Member Tweedie stated that technically after this meeting, without amendment, it moves forward. It was moved forward and there does not need to be another vote unless there was a change or an edit." Selectman Jenness suggested that it be put on the agenda for the June meeting stating that. Motion by Ray Tweedie to move the proposed rule changes to the June 10, 2014 meeting so it may be posted on the agenda. Seconded by Keriann Roman. All in favor.</p>
