THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Rye Water District in the Town of Rye in the County of Rockingham in said State qualified to vote in District affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Rye Junior High School in said Rye on the twenty-ninth (28) day of March next, at 10:00 in the morning to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose a Commissioner for the ensuing three (3) years.
2. To choose a Treasurer for the ensuing three (3) years.
3. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$30,000.00 to be placed in the District's existing Distribution System Replacement and Improvement Capital Reserve Fund established for the purpose of replacing or enlarging the distribution system.

4. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$15,000.00 to be placed in the District's existing Expendable General Fund Trust Fund established to meet the costs of unanticipated expenses occurring during the fiscal year.

5. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$15,000.00 to be placed in the District's existing Equipment and Buildings Capital Reserve Fund established for the purpose of purchase, repair, modification, or replacement of equipment and buildings that support operation of the water distribution system.

6. To see if the District will vote to approve an agreement made between the Rye Water District Commissioners and the City of Portsmouth to provide a supply of water to a proposed ten (10) lot subdivision of single family residential homes located off Breakfast hill Rd on the property of Sewall in the Town of Greenland.

7. (By Petition) Shall we adopt the provisions of RSA 40:13 (known as SB2) to allow official ballot voting on all issues before the Rye Water District on the second Tuesday of March? (3/5 majority vote required)

8. To see if the district will vote to raise and appropriate the \$1,152,261 for general district operations and to defray water district charges for the ensuing year. This article does not include appropriations contained in any other articles addressed.
