

Description: Currently, the intersection of Lang and Lafayette Roads is highly dysfunctional as there are few options to signalize the intersection due to its proximity to Suzanne Drive and other commercial driveways. Most traffic turning left from Lang Road today is looking to then turn right onto Ocean Road to continue westbound. This traffic movement continues to cause large numbers of collisions which in turn costs the City money due to the need for emergency services. This project would build a connector road so that westbound traffic could continue onto Longmeadow Road to the signal at Ocean and Lafayette and then either continue west onto Ocean Road or go south on Lafayette Road. Traffic that seeks to go north toward the City center would be able to continue down Lang Road and take a right as they do today. The City is working with Service Credit Union in order to acquire the land for the new road. The State has funds available to contribute to the project.

Status: Design is underway.
