RYE IS UNDER ATTACK FROM VERIZON.

Threat: Against numerous established variances, Rye Town Ordinances and wetlands protection; in conflict with the Rye Town Master Plan, Verizon has applied to install a 130' cell phone tower at a residential site 120 Brackett Rd. After 5 ½ months and many meetings, with a deadline of Sept. 4th for an up or down vote by the Zoning Board of Adjustment:

- Verizon has not yet presented a final application or site plan for the Zoning Board of Adjustment or Planning Board. So far 10 site plans have been submitted. None are correct.
- The Zoning Board and the Planning Board ask questions, ask for accurate information, present alternate sites; they diligently defend Rye's values and ordinances.
- Verizon's responses have been to refuse to answer questions, or give incomplete and contradictory answers, submit conflicting site plans, not complete their application, refuse to consider alternative sites and generally disregard our town's established procedures and practices.
- When our Boards argue proper information is not available to make a decision, Verizon representatives respond by declaring publicly a threat to sue Rye, NH in Federal Court if the application is denied.

PERSONAL ACTION IS REQUIRED WHY YOU MUST ATTEND THIS MEETING!!!

Rye is being bullied by Verizon. They want us to disregard our values, our vision, our neighbors and neighborhoods, our established policies and procedures to allow them to build this cell phone tower. Further they said, when this one is built they will look for other sites in Rye because they need more towers.

Your attendance at the ZBA meeting Sept. 4th at Rye Town Hall at 7 PM is essential to show Verizon we refuse to be bullied. We support our Zoning Board and Planning Board. It is important to show up at this meeting.

- The Zoning Board will be voting that night. They have the power to deny the application. Let's show support to give our Zoning Board confidence to vote denial.
- If you care about the residential nature of Rye, show up to oppose installing an industrial cell tower on Brackett Road.
