



Beach Parking

Suggestions on the Parking Issue in Rye

- Only park on the ocean side of Rt. 1A: This is much safer, as beach goers will not have to cross Rt. 1A. This will also allow cars to move over for people on bikes and people walking down the road.
- Beach Parking Permits: At the present time there have been 2199 Beach Parking Permits issued and only 120 – 130 parking slots available at seven locations (Cable Road Extension, Wallis Road Extension, Sawyer's Beach, Easterly side of Rt. 1A on the public beach access opposite Petey's, Jenness Avenue Extension, Atlantic Avenue Extension and Old Town Way).
 - The tax payers in Rye should have more parking slots available. For Example: On a nice day there are approximately 21 cars that can park legally on Perkins Road (on the left side as you head away from the beach). On an average day 8 – 10 cars are from Canada, another 5 – 6 are from out of state and the rest of the cars are from NH.
 - Suggestion: Make the parking slots on Perkins Road and the other extension roads for Permit Only Parking.

Note: The town is having the Parking Issue reviewed by an outside group but many of the town residents have express some of the thoughts mentioned above so it is important that the Town hear the town's tax payers.
