



Rye Beach Committee – 2017

Car Count – Sunday, July 2 ... submitted by Larry Rocha

CONDITIONS: Sunny, 85 degrees with a slight breeze

Wallis Sands to Rye Harbor: Total of 193 cars with several large RVs (one from VT and 4 from Quebec)

- NH = 81 = 42%, MA = 58 = 30%, Quebec = 46 = 24%, Others = 8 = 4%

Locke Road to the Carriage House: Total of 146 cars with 7 large RVs (all from Quebec)

- NH = 59 = 40%, MA = 37 = 25%, Quebec = 43 = 30%, Others = 7 = 5%

Jeness Beach Parking Lot: Total of 69 cars

- NH = 23 = 33%, MA = 15 = 22%, Quebec = 25 = 36%, Others = 6 = 9%
- **NOTE:** Many times during the year there are 4 – 5 large trailers, vans and RVs (usually at the northern end of the parking lot on the beach side) that take up extra spaces. This is in part because they leave extra space between the vehicles so they can set up chairs.

Perkins Road: Total of 21 cars

- NH = 6 = 29%, MA = 3 = 14%, Quebec = 10 = 48%, Others = 2 = 9%
- **NOTE:** There were also 6 cars parking in the yard of the lady's house on the corner of Perkins Road and Bernard Drive. There were also 9 cars parked on Maple Avenue (NH = 3, MA = 2, Quebec = 4)

Sawyers Beach: All but 4 cars were from NH. All but 3 cars from NH had Beach Parking Permits.
