Decision:

The Board voted 3-2 to grant variances from the following sections of the Zoning Ordinance:

- Section 603.1 for expansion of a non-conforming structure;
- Section 304.4 for a dwelling height of 33.16 +/-;
- Section 204.3 B for a retaining wall 0' from the side boundary;
- Section 204.3 B for steps 5.8' from right side boundary;
- Section 204.3 B for the house 6.59' from right side boundary and 8.8' from the left side boundary; and
- Section 202.5 for septic system 10.84' from the side boundary.

The Board voted 3-2 to grant relief from the following section of the Building Code:

• Section 7.9.2.5 for septic system 10.84' from the side boundary.

Each variance and building code relief was conditioned upon continued compliance with the following conditions:

- 1. The pavers are installed and regularly maintained so as to remain permeable;
- 2. A stormwater management plan is submitted to and approved by the Building Department; and
- 3. Native plantings are installed and maintained in the area in front of the seawall and the area of the dune as per the December 22, 2018 letter of the Rye Conservation Commission and as shown on the Plan entitled NHDES Wetland/Shoreland Plan dated 03-26-2019.
