## Rye Public Library Board of Trustees – Minutes Public Session May 20, 2020 Virtual

The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Jeff Ross, at 3:00 PM on Zoom. Mr. Ross read the Freedom of Information Act pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order. The Pledge of Allegiance was waived.

This special meeting was called to discuss the Property Maintenance Agreement approved by the Board of Selectmen on May, 19<sup>th</sup> in a meeting that Trustees Ross, Oliver, Azzi, and Moody attended.

Director Richmond asked for the Board's approval to send a letter to the Technology Administrator of SAU50 which allows SAU50 the ability to step away from their commitment to the RPL for Integrated Library System (ILS) service. The current service is no longer compliant with the state's privacy requirements and SAU50 needs to seek a new service that is compliant with the state's requirements. At 4:55 Ms. Oliver moved to approve the letter and Mr. Ross seconded. The Board was polled and all were in favor.
