Article 2021-2022 Operating Budget
01

Shall the Rye School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$14,860,999 (Fourteen Million Eight Hundred Sixty Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$14,626,583 (Fourteen Million Six Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Rye School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (Majority vote required.) (NOTE: This warrant article [operating budget] does not include appropriations in ANY other warrant article.)

The Rye School Board recommends the operating budget. (Vote 5-0)

Article Technology Expendable Trust Fund

To see if the Rye School District will vote to establish a Technology Expendable Trust Fund per RSA 198:20-c, V for the purpose of funding future technology needs in Rye School District and to raise and appropriate up to \$50,000 (Fifty Thousand Dollars) to come from June 30, 2021 unassigned fund balance to be placed in the fund; further to name the school board as agents to expend from the fund. Recommendations Required. (Majority vote required)

The Rye School Board recommends this warrant article. (Vote 5-0)

Article Retainage

To see if the Rye School District will vote in accordance with RSA 198:4-b, II to increase indefinitely until rescinded, the retention of any unused portion of the year-end unassigned general funds from the preceding year from the current percentage of 2.5% to 5% of the current fiscal year's net assessment under RSA 198:5 for the purpose of having funds on hand to use in subsequent fiscal years. (Majority vote required)

The Rye School Board recommends this warrant article. (Vote 5-0)

Article Solar Installation at Rye Junior High and Rye Elementary Schools

To see if the District will vote to authorize the Rye School Board to enter into an easement agreement not to exceed 25 years with ReVision Energy to install roof-mounted solar systems at Rye Elementary School and Rye Junior High School, and further to authorize the School Board to enter into a Solar Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with ReVision Energy for a term not to exceed 25 years with an option to purchase the solar systems after 6 years subject to appropriations, on such terms and conditions as the School Board determines are in the best interest of the District.

The Rye School Board recommends this warrant article. (Vote 5-0)
