What the Planning Administrator said about the Master Plan update.

In 2021 Rye allocated \$8,000 for the Master Plan visioning section update. An additional \$2,500 of funds and \$2,500 of "in-kind effort" would have had to be contributed if \$10K PREPA granted would have been awarded to Rye.
