### Highlights

### **Details**

#### **Warrant Article**

Warrant article to extend last year's request for matching funds for TAP Grant. If awarded the grant the warrant article makes the needed funds available to start the project.

#### **Town Green**

Mae Bradshaw will go to the Select Board to ask them to expand the scope of the Rye Town Center to include the Town Green located on Central Road in front of Central Cemetery. The new Town Center would start at south end of the Town Green to 150 feet beyond Grange Park on Wallis and Washington Roads.

#### **Trolley Barn**

The committee expressed support for the new owner of the Trolley Barn who is intending to open a copy shop on the property. Though no one expressed support for a drive through at this location the committee is in favor of working with the new owner. The committee will engage with abutters to be sure they are representing the needs / desires of the residents of the Rye Town Center

#### **Traffic Safety**

DPWD will be doing the striping along Central Road and Washington Road by the Congregational church to narrow the road to 10 foot lanes on either side. Continued discussion required for Lang Road intersection with Washington Road. Baby steps.
