Details

- Alternate application from Mary Mitchell approved. The commission welcomes Mary to the team
- Temporary signs – there are temporary signs and movable signs. The HDC looked at options and nothing seems much better than what is already in the district. The signs that appeal most are blackboard type which are not practical. Suggestion to design a sign and bring it to a sign maker to see if we can get something that fits with the district and does not add burden to the impacted properties in the district.
- Planning for the candlelight stroll continues. This will likely be a kick-off to the 2023 celebrations. The stroll would occur on the same day as the parade with the intention of having the tree lighting at dusk. The HDC is going to reach out to other groups that may be interested in helping to organize the event. This would highlight the houses in the district and end with lighting the tree in Parsons Field.
- There is a small committee of Rye residents working to place signs around town highlighting historic locations. The proposal will come before HDC for approval.
