

Electricity Update

Eversource rates are increasing, the supply portion of your electricity, from the present 10.669 cents per KWh to 22.566 cents per KWh effective August 1. This is due primarily to increases in natural gas prices. For clarity as to the process, Eversource goes to the energy market every 6 months, to purchase electricity. Other third party suppliers, purchase power utilizing a “portfolio approach” spreading out demand over a much longer time interval to minimize periods of price peaks.

Back to August 1 - Including the delivery charges, Eversource bills will increase from approximately 21.7 cents per KWh to approximately 33.6 cents per KWh on August 1, and increase of roughly 55%.

To minimize this impact, there are options to purchase energy from third party suppliers.

At this time the lowest rate is Direct Energy Live Brighter 30. It is 12.7 cents per KWh for a fixed period of 30 months, without any cancellation fee. 888-548-7540

This allows the option to purchase from others, including Rye Community Power, when PUC has finalized their requirements
