Anne Gilbert, entry plan goals:

Goal 1: Orient my understanding of the SAU 50 Plan for Effective Teaching in order to implement it with the staff at RJH.

Goal 2: To gain a comprehensive understanding of the Rye School District to include policies, procedures, and budgeting for all aspects of the school- curriculum, maintenance, staffing, technology.

Goal 4: To gain a deep understanding of curriculum and assessment practices and analyze student data to identify goals for instruction and student progress.

Accomplishments and Successes

Goal 2:

As we prepare for the January 25 NH Homeland Security Safety Assessment, the front office team is examining all practices and procedures, as well as classroom and school messaging pertinent to safety. Our students have not had recent practice in lockdown procedures, and after a recent drill, we have a clear outline of what we need to work on as a staff with emergency personnel.

Goal 3:

Although this is really Michelle's news, this will be the first year RES will have a drama production! To help promote this new event, RJH students will be serving as mentors to help

our younger students present their production. In addition, Michelle, Jeffrey Elwood, and I are co-sponsoring a PTA grant to provide equipment needed for both productions.

Goal 4:

The leadership team is revisiting behavioral expectations around our school, and identifying ways we can support students as they develop coping skills to manage themselves and their environment. We have noticed that our students' abilities in these areas were negatively impacted over the last few years, and they require more support and structure in their day to day interactions. Our focus will be on consequences that are restorative in nature, and allow students time to reflect and the ability to demonstrate improved behavior.

Goal 2:

Our Safety Committee is looking forward to the Safety Assessment next week. We are ready and willing to make the necessary adjustments to ensure our school is as safe as possible, and that the people inside the building are able to respond to any event with preparedness and knowledge.

Goal 3:

Our UA teachers have worked with Greenland teachers to learn more about developing a personalized approach to unified arts classes. This work will also blend with our Schedule Committee, which will look at how to best utilize our school day for students and learning.
