Bike Racks have been approved by the Select Board for beaches at Cable and Wallis. The Beach Committee hopes to recommend more sites in the future. Beach sites are limited in some areas, due to the proximity to NH State owned property, beaches or roads.

Dog Waste Containers have been approved by the Select Board to remain in place at Wallis & Cable. While most dog owners are responsible, we are concerned about those who disregard the rules. Dog waste is not biodegradable, whether it is left on the beach, on the road or on grass. We will continue to look for solutions and coordinate with other groups in Rye.

Before the summer season begins, we are planning a beach walk with representatives of the fire and police departments. Our goal is to check on beach access points and make sure no one is using plants or chairs to block paths or space on the beach. Any of these issues can lead to safety issues for beachgoers walking to the beach or create crowding in front of a neighbor's home.
