- 31 people attended representing 17 roads in Rye
- History of speeding in Rye shows:
  - many of speed limit signs date to last century
- speeds are inconsistent on many roads such as Washington and Central where they go from 30 to 35 mph w/ same housing density
- 2000 houses have been built in Rye in last 70 years adding to density of driveways and number of people and bikers on road
  - 35 mph speed limit signs should be eliminated.
- Majority spoke and want speeds lowered and other actions taken such as more digital speed monitoring signs
- -- Select Board has authority to set town road speed limits and enact a traffic ordinance RSA 265:63
