Re: Emergency Management Budget

Town of Rye is in the emergency planning zone (EPZ). There is 1 drill scheduled for Oct 18th, 2023 and 2 drills planned for the calendar year 20224. Rye emergency management participates in all 3 drills every other year. The Town of Rye is in the emergency planning zone (EPZ) and participates to ensure Rye employees are prepared should there be an actual event at Seabrook Nuclear Power Plant.

Equipment in the emergency operation center had some equipment repairs completed in 2021 and 2022. So far everything has been working. Each year Rye Emergency Management requests a computer through NH Homeland Security and Seabrook Nuclear Power Plant (REP) program. The computer continues to be denied. The computer is in poor condition. I am requesting the equipment request again based on the amount of the computer is used if for EPZ drills vs Town of Rye business use.

The generator is in good shape however the last major repair and overview/tune up was March of 2022. I am equesting Milton Cat to service the generator for a tune up in 2024. Estimated cost for tune-up \$1,800.00. This is to keep up with preventative maintenance.

Training continues with Town of Rye employees learning the Radeoff equipment. Every two years procedures are reviewed and updated. Due to a turn over of town employees Rye EMD has replaced some positions. Town employees in the new positions will need training, example, WEB FOC training and other related Homeland Security training.

September 28, 2022 NH Homeland Security provided allocation of funds to support radiological emergency preparedness (REP) for Town of Rye, July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, total \$10,236.00. In April of 2023 I made a funding request of \$14,861.00 to support the REP for Town of Rye EMD program. I have not received noticed for funding the July 2023 to June 2024 fiscal year.
