- Describe what measures can be taken to minimize the cost of such litigation and to effect a resolution at the earliest reasonable date

ween November first and December first of each year the Select Board shall conduct a Public Hearing and report on the status of all litigation and appeals in which the Town has been engaged during the year and the costs expenses associated therewith.
