TAC Recommendation

Our TAC representative will facilitate Rye's needs at the decision-making level via TAC meetings for the current term ending 12/31/25, by:

- Acquiring early knowledge about transportation initiatives and new federal, state and regional funding sources
- Providing local insight and expertise on planning activities regarding highways, bicycles, pedestrians, transit, and other areas of transportation
- Providing input regarding regional transportation projects in NH's 10 year plan
- Engaging in professional development and networking opportunities through collaborating with other local experts and professionals

At the 4/16/24 Planning Board, the Applicants should be prepared to discuss their experience and abilities to meet the needs of the TAC and Planning Board, as follows:

TAC work –

1. Informing the development of strategies and programs aimed at goals like reducing congestion, improving air quality, and providing more transportation choices for the region.
2. Providing input and guidance informing how the Planning Commission makes transportation decisions and recommendations on major work products on regional initiatives such as the development of the Safety Action Plan and Long Range Transportation Plan.
3. Bringing attention to transportation safety, mobility, accessibility, sustainability, and resilience issues in the region.
4. Bringing tangible improvements to your community like repaving, sidewalks, crosswalks, successfully repaired bridges, culvert improvements, safer intersections, stronger speed management, and public transit.

Planning Board assistance –

1. Attending PB meetings twice a year: June/July in advance of RnR activities, and in December to provide an annual update.
2. Reviewing and providing comment on the Master Plan (MP) Existing Conditions Analysis (Draft 1/29/24) - especially Transportation and Coastal Resilience.
3. Participating in a Master Plan Steering Committee meeting to discuss TAC adjacent topics, preferably prior to drafting the body of the MP.
4. Providing guidance to the PB on transportation matters raised during site plan and subdivision reviews, if/as requested.
5. Providing minutes of each TAC meeting to the Planning and Zoning Administrator for inclusion in the PB monthly packages.
