

Rec Commission Meeting Minutes March 21, 2024 5:30PM

The Commission had an emergency meeting to discuss and vote on the Turf Maintenance bids.

The meeting was called to order at 5:40pm

Dyana discussed the two bids that came in. One was Seaside Landscaping, and the other was North Atlantic Landscaping. Unfortunately, the North Atlantic Landscaping bid did not come in on time therefore there was only one bid to choose from.

Cory then made a motion to recommend the Seaside Landscaping bid in the amount of \$18,992.00 to the Selectboard for final approval. Brett seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Dyana brought up the Easter Egg Dig. She stated that it was going to be postponed until March 30th due to the inclement weather forecast for Saturday the 23rd. Everyone agreed and all could still help except for Brett and Jon who were both going to be out of town on the 30th.

Cory then brought up that the Rye Little League would be doing their annual spring cleaning on April 6th this year.

Dyana then brought up a quick note that she was setting up a show for the community, that is family friendly, called Scriptless in Seattle. This show would be an improv show like "Whose Line is it Anyway?" and the date for the program was going to be May 31 at Rye Elementary School. Info and tickets sales will be in the works soon.

Dyana then asked the commissioners to take a vote on where to take the money out of the budget for the additional renderings that Ironwood did for the Master Plan. It was decided to take it out of the property maintenance line. Cory made the motion to take it out of that line in the budget and Richard seconded the motion. It was unanimous.

Cory called for an adjournment, seconded by Jon, unanimous – the meeting adjourned at 6:15pm.
