### Start of Year

It has been an amazing start to the school year across the SAU. Dave and I are on a "roadshow" to each school to meet with staff to share our progress on the Strategic Plan and to solicit feedback.

For example, we will feature at least one characteristic from the Portrait of a Learner each month with student examples. Another effort this year will be educating parents on recent research and school practices related to student cell phones. This is a topic that has been a focus across multiple schools and was a particular area of interest for some teachers to explore during our Innovation Conference this past summer.

## Strategic Plan Update

We continue to solicit feedback on the Strategic Plan as we meet with the staff at each school. Dave has been updating the document (<u>Updated Strategic Plan</u>) and we hope to gain the approval of the Joint Board on September 25th to move forward with this plan. It may be important to know that each school will then create a school-specific plan based on this, which will include more details about goals, strategies and timelines specific to each school building. Those plans will also be shared with each Board as they are developed this year.



# **Internet Use Protocol**

Chris Ruso discovered that our policy for acceptable internet use (IICL)refers to internet acceptable use procedures that are to be approved annually. These procedures are what we should be having students/parents sign off on and up until this point we have had them sign off on the policy itself. The procedures are in your drive and can be found <u>here</u>. We would ask for your approval so we can have them distributed for signing. They have been vetted by the Tech Committee.

## **Proposed Policies**

The Policy Committee is recommending the following policies for a single reading adoption: **ADB:** Drug-Free Workplace & Drug-Free Schools **ADC:** Prohibitions Regarding Use and Possession of Tobacco Products, E-Cigarettes and E-Liquids in and on School Facilities and Grounds **GBCD-RG (1):** Background Investigation and Criminal History Records Check **GBEC:** Drug-Free Workplace & Drug-Free Schools **GBED:** Prohibitions Regarding Use and Possession of Tobacco Products, E-Cigarettes and E-Liquids in and on School Facilities and Grounds

These policies all reflect minor changes in statute are were in the Spring Policy Update as Required by Law sample policies. The Drug-Free Workplace policies appear in two sections, A and G, hence the repetition. An example of the level of change is now it is required to explicitly say we will not give tobacco to kids. Not sure if anyone thought it was an option before  $\bigcirc$ .
