SUMMARY:

GBGBA/JLCEA/KFD: Use of Automated External Defibrillators

- This is a tri-coded policy **GBGBA/JLCEA/KFD**
- Districts may, but need not, maintain all three. If choosing to maintain one, NHSBA recommends using KFD
- Reclassified as "Priority/Required by Law", and revised in response to passage of SB379 o Amended provision in RSA 200:40-c (sports injury plans) relating to: location of AEDs maintenance of AEDs (the required maintenance provision was already in paragraph 3 of the earlier version of KFD).

JLF: Reporting Child Abuse or Neglect

- No statutory change
- Revised after consultation with representatives of DCYF and the Granite State Children's Alliance ("Know and Tell")
- Changes include:
 - o Clarifying reporting requirements (employees may not use "anonymous" mode)
 - o Adds a report form o Clarifies record keeping

- o Removes the notation that periodic training was not required (now required under RSA 189:13-a, XII and sample policy GBCE)

JLP: Parental Notification of and Involvement in Student Welfare

- Created in response to passing of HB 1312, which, among other things, created new IX-e RSA 186:11, IX-e
- Requires a policy relating to disclosure/disclosure to parents of information concerning a student's mental, emotional or physical health
